

## Butyl Sealant

---

### 1 Material

- 1.1. This product is a semi-solid paste based on butyl rubber polybutene blends with inorganic fillers, plasticisers, and flow modifiers.
- 

### 2 Health Hazards

- 2.1. All these ingredients are non-volatile and have low toxicity.
  - 2.2. The major ingredients can be regarded as essentially harmless.

### 3 Storage & Handling

- 3.1. Butyl sealants are sticky and will adhere to skin, hair, clothes etc.
  - 3.2. As with any material, normal good hygiene practices should be followed.
  - 3.3. Do not eat or otherwise ingest any material, keep away from food and out of reach of children and pets.
  - 3.4. Avoid unnecessary contact with skin.
  - 3.5. Wash off with water or proprietary hand cleaner, keep out of eyes.
  - 3.6. Do not smoke whilst handling the product.

### 4 Fire Hazards

- 4.1. None of these products contain volatile solvents; therefore, there is no associated flash point.
  - 4.2. In a fire the organic components (mainly the rubbers and plasticisers) will burn, giving off smoke and carbon dioxide.
  - 4.3. There are no PVC ingredients that could give off toxic fumes.
  - 4.4. Any form of fire extinguisher can be used.
