

Colortite Moulded Nylon Head onto Carbon & Stainless Steel Fasteners



Material

- 1.1. Nylon moulded heads on carbon or stainless steel fasteners.
- 1.2. Fasteners—Plated components, passivation solutions used include fluorides and chromates and whilst the parts are thoroughly rinsed during production, low concentrations may remain on the surface which in the case of prolonged contact could cause irritation to the skin or mucous membranes.
- 1.3. Moulded Nylon Head—Generally non-hazardous, manufactured from modified Nylon materials.

Health Hazards

- 2.1. Self drilling screws in common with all other drilling operations produce swarf; this may be thrown outwards while the product is being fixed.
- 2.2. Self drilling and self tapping screws must be installed using a suitable and correctly set up screw gun, as the torque build up during and at the completion of installation can cause 'kick back' which could result in injury if the clutch mechanism of these screw guns does not come into use.

Storage & Handling

- 3.1. Store in dry conditions.
- 3.2. Always wash you hands immediately after handling plated products and whenever possible wear gloves.
- 3.3. Never allow plated products or gloves, that have been used to handle plated products to come into contact with food or drink, or cups and plates etc, that will be used for food or drink.
- 3.4. Avoid prolonged exposure and do not smoke or eat whilst handling plated goods.
- 3.5. Do not chew or swallow moulded head fasteners.

Fire Hazards

4.1. Nylon releases toxic gas when burnt; avoid inhaling smoke and fumes if the product catches fire.
